

Dr. Harold A. Hudson is the Senior Pastor of Calvary Tremont Missionary Baptist Church and has served in that capacity since 1996. Prior to becoming the Senior Pastor at Calvary Tremont, Pastor Hudson was the Senior Pastor of The New Hope Baptist Church in Hillsboro, Ohio from 1988 to 1996.
